Jim and Alex Tsunis of The Northwind Group presented a proposal for change of zone from industrial to multifamily for property on Baylis Avenue south of the railroad track. The property is 5.6 acres 56 units proposed development would include 16 townhomes and 40 one bedroom apartments 8 buildings total. The units would be affordable rentals for young professionals. Members raised concerns regarding school age children encouraged the developer to reach out to the school district and Stonybrook University. The Northwind Group currently owns the property and were looking to apply for change of zone in about 30 days. A letter of no objection will be provided to the Town Board as per unanimous vote by the PJSTCA with the provision the developer will advise and update the PJSTCA on all matters going forward.

Debra Engelhardt Director of The Comsewogue Public Library provided updated information regarding library hours, programs for seniors including tax assistance, LI Cares food bank, food pantry, art exhibitions, new English speakers via Zoom, and take and make kits.
